



# AICPA/Accountemps Student Scholarship

## 2010 – 2011 Academic Year

**Scholarship Overview:** The AICPA/Accountemps Student Scholarship program provides financial assistance to students who are majoring in accounting, finance or information systems. These awards are intended to encourage students to consider careers in accounting and business.

**Award Amount:** \$2,500 per recipient for one year. The award will be sent directly to the school for credit to the account of the student.

**Number of Recipients:** 5

**Deadline:** April 1, 2010 (postmarked)

**Selection Process:** A task force, comprised of AICPA and RHI/Accountemps representatives, will review all qualified applications and select five scholarship recipients based on demonstrated outstanding academic achievement, leadership and future career interests in accounting and business. All applicants will be notified of the final selection by August 1, 2010.

**Eligibility Requirements:** Eligible applicants must satisfy all of the prerequisites listed below. Initial next to each requirement to verify that you meet the requirement. *AICPA and RHI/Accountemps staff and close kin are not eligible for this award.*

1. I am a declared accounting, finance, or information systems major.	
2. I will be a full-time undergraduate (12 semester hours or equivalent) or a full-time master's level student (9 semester hours or equivalent) at an accredited college or university in the United States for Fall 2010 and Spring 2011.	
3. I have completed at least 30 semester hours (or equivalent) of college coursework, including at least 6 semester hours (or equivalent) in accounting.	
4. I have maintained an overall GPA and major GPA of at least 3.0.	
5. I am a U.S. citizen or permanent resident (Green Card holder).	
6. I am not presently a CPA.	
7. I am an AICPA student affiliate member (or have recently submitted a new member application). <i>Membership application and information is available at <a href="http://ceae.aicpa.org/Memberships">http://ceae.aicpa.org/Memberships</a></i>

1. A completed and signed application form (pages 1-3).	
2. Official academic transcript(s) from post-secondary school(s) attended (through the fall term 2009). <i>Original official certified transcripts must include school stamp, embossed seal, or authorized school official signature. Copies will not be accepted. Include your transcript(s) in your one application envelope.</i>	
3. A copy of your spring term 2010 course schedule.	
4. Graduate school admission test score report(s) (if applicable). <i>Photocopies of score reports are acceptable.</i>	
5. A one-page, typed (single or double-spaced) essay discussing your academic and professional goals.	
6. Two signed letters of recommendation on letterhead stationery. <i>Letters of recommendation should be from individuals who can speak knowledgeably of your professional and academic experience and of your qualifications for a career in business. References should comment on your communication, problem-solving and decision-making skills, as well as your ability to work with others.</i>
